Introduction (1/3)

- This is a brief summary of what is proposed in **Addendum 4.4.**
- It is obvious that the digital transformation of processes and organisations is advancing at a rapid pace on a worldwide scale.
- The OIML is part of this transformation!
- Significant work and collaboration have already occurred through the OIML/BIPM Joint Task Group and the Quality Infrastructure Partners to progress the digital transformation of processes relating to metrology, standardisation, accreditation and conformity assessment.







Introduction (2/3)

- We are still at the very beginning of the worldwide digitalisation process!
- We need a group of experienced individuals, who are able to cooperate and collaborate with the QI partners, and to represent and promote the interests of the legal metrology community in this process.
- I therefore propose to establish an OIML Digitalisation Task Group, the purpose and task of which would be to examine all relevant matters, technological advancements and opportunities related to digital transformation that will benefit the OIML, in cooperation with the QI partners.
- The Task Group would need to define the appropriate scope of its work, including appropriate Terms of Reference, membership and operating rules, deliverables and outcomes.







Introduction (3/3)

- As part of its Terms of Reference, the Task Group would also need to execute and deliver, with assistance provided by the BIML, the guidance, objectives and policy decisions of the Conference, the CIML, the OIML/BIPM JTG, etc.
- Appropriately experienced individuals may express their interest in joining this Task Group through their CIML Member, Corresponding Member Representative or liaison organisation delegate to the CIML.
- It is envisaged that the Task Group will comprise of not more than 10 members of which a chair and deputy will be elected.
- Nominations shall be made to the CIML President in the form of a letter of motivation sent to the BIML by 30 November 2021.
